Philanthropists


Philanthropists will invest **risk based capital** if they see measurable innovative results.

Governments

Governments need to believe adoption is their idea and that it compliments social protection programs (not a replacement). Cocreate and give government ownership. Building support at all levels of government helps protect against political changes.

Holistic Model

Graduation messaging can be tailored to appeal to multiple stakeholder concerns



Research Needs

- What research drives policy and adoption decision making?
- Is there a way to leapfrog adoption without pilots or a way to speed pilot process?
- Implementers are interested in operational research, examples include:
- ROI and efficiency of various components of the program
 - Cash vs. Asset Transfer
- Importance of sequencing
- Opportunity cost of not doing graduation
- Better evaluation tools

By aligning on outcomes, we can drive support and adoption with more powerful unified messaging
